<p>The purpose of the course: A student understands a critical mind mainly on forensic duties and thinks about a study theme by oneself and accomplishes one's study.</p> <p>The arrival target of the course: A student studies a theme by oneself and publishes an article in journal and acquires a degree after examination.</p> <p>The summary of the course: The student conducts a study to contribute to improvement of the cause of death diagnostic technique through a forensic autopsy cases. Depending on the request of the student, the instructor instructs about forensic radiology (CT, panoramic X-ray equipment, ultrasonic diagnostic equipment) and clinical forensic medicine.</p>

<p>Information about the course: In the department of forensic sciences, we deal with personal information and investigation information about the forensic autopsy. The student should adhere rigidly to confidentiality.</p> <p>This course plans a lecture, forensic autopsy training, forensic case studies. A student may participate in case conference.</p> <p>When a student cannot attend at the course by duty, the instructor accepts the adjustment of the schedule. In addition, the student may participate in forensic autopsy in a holiday and the night. The student should talk with an instructor before deciding the study of the course.</p> <p>By a qualification and career that the student has, the instructor may adjust study contents.</p> <p>A textbook, references: Depending on a study theme, an instructor may introduce appropriate literature.</p> <p>Learning contents in study period: The student should prepare the content of the course.</p>
